"Young Voices, One Mission: Promoting Peace Across Religions."

Project Presentation Competition

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**Rationale:**

Sarasa Ektra School successfully presented the "Extra Peace" project concept at the Youth Social Hackathon competition organized by the Catholic Education Council of Thailand on July 14, 2024. Subsequently, the Catholic Education Council of Thailand provided funding support to the school to implement the project. The main objective of the initiative is to provide young people with an opportunity to engage in interfaith dialogue, thereby promoting peace and harmony across Asia.

The goal of the "Extra Peace" initiative is to foster innovators who can inspire world peace and build a youth network. This will be achieved through the combination of Flipped Classroom and Project-Based Learning approaches, creating a platform for young people to develop and present projects in English under the theme "Young Voices, One Mission: Promoting Peace Across Religions." Participants are competing for prizes and grants amounting to 35,000 Baht.

**Registration Process:** 29<sup>th</sup> August - 7<sup>th</sup> September 2024 via Google Form

**Objectives:**

1. To promote awareness of religious conflicts, leading to peaceful exchanges of perspectives within society.
2. To provide a platform for youth to voice their views on religious conflicts and peacebuilding by presenting projects designed to address these issues.
3. To address the issues raised in the 9th resolution of the FABC 50 regarding peacebuilding and unity in Asia and to contribute to achieving the United Nations Sustainable Development Goal 16, which promotes peaceful and inclusive societies for sustainable development.

### Eligibility Criteria:

1. High school students (Grades 10–12 or equivalent) from educational institutions nationwide who are interested in creating innovative projects.
2. Students must be enrolled in schools registered with the Ministry of Education.
3. Each school may submit up to 2 teams, each consisting of 4 students, with at least 1 advisor per team.

### Conditions for Participation:

1. All participating teams must attend the **Orientation Meeting via Google Meet** held on **9<sup>th</sup> September 2024**.
2. All participating teams are required to complete three lessons available on [www.extrapeace.org](http://www.extrapeace.org) and complete the exercises at the end of each lesson.
3. All participating teams must attend **two discussion sessions via Google Meet** on the specified dates and times, which will be scheduled after the three lessons. The date and time will be announced later.
4. All participating teams must present original work that is not plagiarized or in violation of copyright or intellectual property rights. In the event of any complaints, the participating team must bear full responsibility.

### Competition Format:

#### 1. Preliminary Round:

Participating teams are required to interpret the **theme “Young Voices, One Mission: Promoting Peace Across Religions”** and collaboratively create an abstract with the following guidelines:

- The abstract must be in English, consist of paragraphs, and **must not exceed 200 words**.
- The title of the abstract must be in **Arial font, size 16, bold**.
- The content of the abstract must be in **Times New Roman font, size 11**.

- Present their project in **English**.
- Each team must submit a presentation of no more than 7 pages in a PDF format, not exceeding 10 MB, by 26<sup>th</sup> November 2024, via **Google Form**.
- Each team will have **5 minutes** for the presentation and **3 minutes** for the Q&A session with the judges.
